University of Regina International Student of Distinction Scholarship Guiding

1. Overview of the Special Scholarship

Each year, one graduate from Kobe Ryukoku High School, a special partner school, will be awarded this special scholarship.

The scholarship provides academically outstanding international students with 12 months of oncampus housing (single room with a private bathroom) and meal costs, equivalent to CAD 20,000 per year.

Scholarships for the second year and beyond will be determined based on academic performance from the previous year.

(If the applicant does not meet the required English proficiency level, the scholarship will begin once the requirement is met.)

2. Eligibility Requirements

- For the first-year scholarship, the applicant must have an overall GPA of 4.0 or higher (on a 5-point scale) in all subjects during their third year of high school. (Higher GPA is preferred.)
- Scholarships for the second year and beyond will be determined based on the student's university grades from the previous year.
- Applicants must enroll in a four-year bachelor's degree program. (Early withdrawal is not allowed.)
- Once awarded, the scholarship cannot be declined.

4. Scholarship Start Date

The scholarship will start in September of the year of high school graduation. (If the required English proficiency is not met, the scholarship will start after fulfilling the requirement.)

5. Academic Requirements for Scholarship Renewal

This scholarship is renewable for up to three years (3.5 years for the Faculty of Engineering & Applied Science).

The conditions for renewal are as follows:

First-Year Students

- Complete a minimum of 30 credit hours (10 courses) within 12 months.
- At least 24 credit hours (8 courses) must have a UGPA of 80% or higher.
- Achieve a minimum UGPA of 75%.

Second-Year & Third-Year Students

- Complete a minimum of 30 credit hours each academic year.
- Achieve a minimum UGPA of 80%.

6. Number of Recipients

One guaranteed spot per year for graduates from Kobe Ryukoku High School. (Additional spots may be considered upon discussion.)

7. Application Documents & Procedures

- High School Transcript (Grade 11 or Grade 12)
- Passport
- CAD 100.00 application fee

8. Number of Recipients

- (4) Processors evaluate application documents and decide if the student meets admission and ISD requirements
- (5) Download LOA from the application portal
- (6) Receive ISD letter by email
- (7) Pay tuition deposit of CAD 1,000
